Bill has provided a statement regarding the upcoming tasting in August:

"The August tasting will feature wines from Loew Vineyards in our neighboring Frederick County. Rachel Lipman, granddaughter of the first Loew to arrive in the United States after World War II and the winemaker for Loew, will be presenting the wines along with the history of winemaking in the Loew family. This history dates back to the 1870's in Eastern Europe. She'll be joined by Christian Orr who manages their tasting room and who many of us know from his time at House of Liquors in Westminster. Wines will be available for purchase if you're interested.

The tasting will be held at the Sadler farmhouse in Gamber, on August 17th at 2pm. Our plan is to have the tasting on the back porch overlooking the meadow unless the heat is too oppressive to handle, so plan to dress casually. Please remember to bring a dish for the communal table."
